2 **July 6, 1923, in Garapan, Salpan; and**

3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Tenorio is married to Soledad Takal Tenorio**
4 **and has six children; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Mr. Tenorio began his employment career prior**
6 **to World War II as a sugarcane field worker; and**

7 **WHEREAS, shortly after the war he entered into his own**
8 **business enterprise, which consisted of a "mom and pop"**
9 **grocery store started on \$20.00 worth of capital; and**

10 **WHEREAS, Mr. Tenorio took that small business and built it**
11 **into a multi-million dollar business empire which consists of**
12 **shopping centers, a hardware and appliance store, a car**
13 **dealership and a major construction company; and**

14 **WHEREAS, Mr. Tenorio is also involved in and a major**
15 **stockholder of many other businesses, too numerous to mention;**
16 **and**

17 **WHEREAS, Mr. Tenorio's activities and accomplishments have**
18 **not been limited to the private sector, but have also included**
19 **significant contributions to government and the community; and**

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Tenorio was one of the co-founders of the
2 Territorial Party, the predecessor of the current Republican
3 Party; and

4 WHEREAS, he was the Treasurer for the Marianas Medical
5 Center in 1977, a Representative of the Mariana Islands District
6 Copra Stabilization Board, under the Trust Territory Government,
7 a member of the Marianas Political Status Commission, and a
8 member and co-founder of the Saipan Chamber of Commerce;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, he is a member of the Board of Trustees of the
11 Ponape Agriculture and Trade School and the Marianas Public
12 Land Trust; and

13 WHEREAS, he has contributed generously both of his time
14 and money to various civic and religious activities and other
15 worthy causes throughout the Micronesian community; and

16 WHEREAS, he is not only a good businessman, devoted
17 father and husband, but a shining example for the youth of the
18 Commonwealth to follow; and

19 WHEREAS, it was this universal awareness of his qualities as
20 a businessman and a humanitarian which led the President of
21 the University of Guam to recommend and the Board of Regents
22 to bestow upon him the honorary degree of Doctor of Laws in
23 recognition of his significant accomplishments and his dedication
24 to the economic, social and political advancement of the Northern

1 Mariana Islands and the entire Western Pacific Region and its
