H. B. NO. 23-70: To establish the offense of drunk and disorderly conduct as a payable infraction; and for other purposes. Introduced by REP. MANNY G. T. CASTRO of Saipan, Precinct 2 (*for himself*, Representatives Roy C.A. Ada, Angelo A. Camacho, Joseph A. Flores, Marissa R. Flores, Thomas J. DlC. Manglona, Julie M. A. Ogo, Malcolm J. Omar, John Paul P. Sablan, and Patrick H. San Nicolas) on September 7, 2023; subsequently referred to the House Committee on Judiciary and Governmental Operations.

H. B. NO. 23-71: To provide disclosure requirements upon transfer of ownership of a vehicle rebuilt from salvage. Introduced by: REP. ANGELO A. No. 23-74: To impose an additional 3% tax on the yearly gross revenue of constructions activities in excess of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) for a period of three years.
