

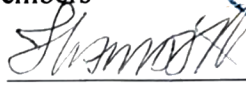

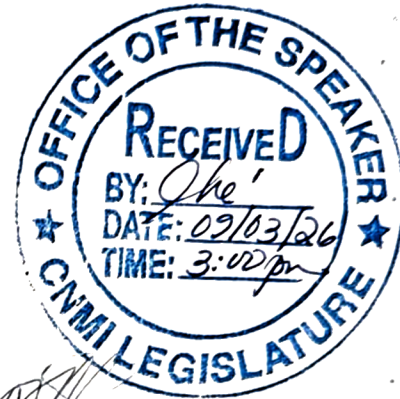

S.B. 24-22, entitled "To establish mandatory presentation of valid personal photo identification for any debit card or credit card transaction made in person and any check cash exchange or purchase for all business establishments in the Commonwealth."

H.B. 24-65, entitled "To transfer the function of business licensing from the Department of Finance to the Department of Commerce; and for other purposes."

H.B. 24-76, entitled "To adopt the village delimitation and name master map for Saipan as the sole village delimitation and name master map of Saipan and to provide for the Office of the Mayor of Saipan to be the primary custodian for maintaining and preserving the master map and for the Department of Commerce - Central Statistics Division to be the secondary custodian; and for other purposes."

H.B. 24-93, entitled "To amend 4CMC § 5611 to Allow for the issuance of two-year business licenses and to require the Department of Commerce and the Department of Finance to jointly promulgate implementing rules and regulations."

H.B. 24-100, entitled "To amend the statutory language governing dormant and unclaimed accounts to clarify the regulatory provisions regarding dormancy periods, the perpetual right of owners to claim funds, and the administration of escheated funds."



S.B. 24-47, entitled "To require all contractors to be licensed in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands; and for other purposes."
