Welcome to YOUR Library! The Joeten-Kiyu Public Library (JKPL) was established in December 21, 1991. NMI PL 7-18 established the Commonwealth Library Council (CLC) and Joeten-Kiyu Public Library as the CNMI State Library. As the designated State Library Administrative Agency (SLAA), JKPL oversees the technical aspects of library operations for the Fernando M. Benavente Memorial Library, the Bookmobile/Technology Mobile Express, the Antonio C. Atalig Memorial Library on Rota (RPL) and the Tinian Public Library (TPL) in collaboration with the respective mayors of both municipalities, leveraging both annual CNMI government appropriations and federal funds primarily from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS).

On December 30, 2022, the Joeten-Kiyu Public Library (JKPL) received a congratulatory letter from Congressman Gregorio "Kilili" Camacho Sablan awarding funding amounts for the following projects:

- \$1,200,000.00 for the Joeten-Kiyu Public Library Solar Power System
- \$436,191.00 for the Public Libraries' (Saipan, Rota, and Tinian) Furniture Upgrade

TAs of FY2024 the status of the two Joeten-Kiyu Public Library projects worth \$1,636,191, are as follows:

- The ITB for Furniture Upgrades for Saipan, Tinian, and Rota Public Libraries is in progress.
- The Joeten-Kiyu Public Library's Solar Power System Project/Architecture and Engineering design (A&E) is being routed through the Secretary of Finance.

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Major developments of Joeten-Kiyu Public Library (JKPL) FY 2024 budget include the following:

- JKPL General Fund 2024 budget allocated for Personnel funding assistance of 94.8% while LSTA federal funds contributed 5.2% funding support.
- Total of \$480,174.00 for 15 employees for 2024.
- Through the assistance from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) LSTA, JKPL was able to carry out library programs and services. Despite the budgetary constraints, JKPL met challenges in efficiency, customer care, and systematic compilation of performance indicators in line with CNMI State Library LSTA Strategic 5-Year Program Goals: Promote Literate NMI, Strengthen Institutional Capacity, Enhance and Maintain NMISL Technology, and Provide Welcoming Library Environments.



P.L. 23-09 appropriated \$459,847 in local funding for FY2024 JKPL. Funding from IMLS LSTA were used to offset personnel and operations.

- Additional donations through the Educational Tax Credit (PL 15-120) assisted JKPL with operational funding support for library programs and activities for Saipan, Tinian, and Rota.
- Utilities budget: As per P.L. 23-09, JKPL did not receive a utilities allocation.
- 23rd Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation (SNILD) allocated \$50,000.00 via SLL 23-06 in funding support for Joeten-Kiyu Public Library professional development, programs and services.
