



- **Senate Legislative Initiative No. 22-01**, *To amend Article XII of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands to remove the restriction on the alienation of land in the CNMI, to allow NMD landowners to fully exercise their real property rights, and to reduce the NMD percentage of ownership interest in a Northern Marianas Descent Corporation.* (Referred to REDP)
- **Senate Legislative Initiative No. 22-02**, *To propose a constitutional amendment to Article V, section 4, of the NMI Constitution to require the Resident Representative to the United States to provide a report to the legislature in a joint session.* (Referred to JGLFR)

- **Senate Legislative Initiative No. 22-03**, *To amend Section 10 of Article III of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands to restrict the governor's emergency powers to mobilize available resources to respond to that emergency within the executive branch but not including the legislative branch, the judicial branch and autonomous agencies.* (Referred to JGLFR)
- **Senate Legislative Initiative No. 22-04**, *To propose a constitutional amendment to Article X, Section 2, of the NMI Constitution to require the governor to provide a report on the social, fiscal and economic impact of tax exemptions.* (Referred to JGLFR)
