- f. HB 22-48: To amend Public Law 21-35, "To make appropriations for the operations and activities of the Government of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, its agencies, instrumentalities, and independent programs, and to provide budget authority for government corporations for Fiscal Year 2021"; and for other purposes.
- g. HB 22-54: To update the definition of tobacco products in the CNMI's excise tax laws; bring tobacco tax rates to the recommended level; set tobacco tax rates to increase with inflation; and invest tobacco tax revenues in health promotion and disease prevention and control programs in the CNMI; and for other purposes.
- h. HB 22-57: To provide a tax credit for business entities that hire United States citizens or residents of the CNMI whose employment was affected by the Vovid-19 pandemic.
- Gov. Comm. 22-29: RENEWAL-Authority of the Secretary of Finance to reprogram or transfer funds from accounts of any department, agency, office, board, commission, corporation, instrumentality or other entity of any branch of the Commonwealth Government in order to meet the threat of Covid-19
