The Northern Marianas Technical Institute (formerly known as the Northern Marianas Trades Institute) is a government entity established by Public Law 20-92 and is governed by seven (7) Board of Trustees and managed by an Administrator. The NMTI strives to provide career, trades, and technical training in occupations not available at the CNMI Public School System and the Northern Marianas College.

The Northern Marianas Technical Institute focuses on meeting the demand for skilled workers who possess certain trade skills and competency particularly in the tourism/hospitality, automotive, culinary arts and construction industries in the CNMI Workforce. The CNMI expects workforce to increase in the next several years with the recent changes in the United States' immigration policies. The Northern Marianas Technical Institute is committed to helping alleviate the inevitable increasing demand in the workforce by providing certain trade skills.

The Northern Marianas Technical Institute invests in students by providing advanced trades, career and technical education to produce skilled individuals and strengthen the CNMI Workforce.

ACCREDITATION



As the economy continues to rebound there is no surprise that the need for skilled trades and technical workers in the CNMI are in great demand. The Northern Marianas Technical Institute was awarded \$10.3 million by the Economic Development Administration through the agency's Economic Adjustment Assistance Program. The project entails the construction of a 29, 239 square foot two story building providing administrative office, instructional and workshop spaces for its trades programs. This new facility will help guide the long-term development and growth of NMTI's strategic priorities that includes the A&E design and construction to house the Institute's student service programs, bookstore, and relevant offices.
