

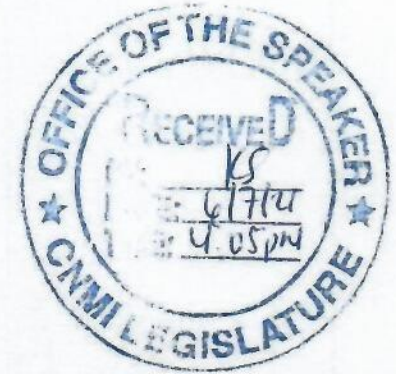

JOHN PAUL P. SABLAN of Saipan, Precinct 2 (for himself, Representatives Roy C.A. Ada; Blas Jonathan "BJ" T. Attao, Ivan A. Blanco, Joel C. Camacho, Angel A. Demapan, Joseph A. e. **H. B. NO. 22-17** - To amend 9 CMC § 2401 to authorize the Bureau of Motor Vehicles to regulate chauffeur licenses in the CNMI; and for other purposes. Prefiled by: REP. JOSEPH LEEPAN T. GUERRERO of Saipan, Precinct 1 (for himself, and Representative Angel A. Demapan)

f. **H. B. NO. 22-18** - To amend Division 4 of Title 6 of the Commonwealth Code relating to disposition of offenders and sentencing to provide criteria for imposition of enhanced sentencing of defendants for crimes motivated by hate. i. **H. B. NO 22-30** – To grand the Legislature a reasonable allowance, to define a "reasonable allowance," to set the amount of the allowance and, to certify it as a public purpose. l. H. B. NO. 22-37 – To amend Title 6, Division 3, Chapter 2 of the Commonwealth Code by establishing a penalty provision for criminal defendants who fail to appear in court on their scheduled date. Pre-filed by REP. CELINA R. BABAUTA of Saipan, Precinct 1 (for herself).

m. H.B. NO. – 22-38 – To amend Title 6, Division 5, Chapter 3, Article 2. Protection of Abused Children, to enact a new § 5326. Discovery of evidence of child abuse or recordings of child witnesses, and for other purposes. Pre-filed by REP. CELINA R. BABAUTA of Saipan, Precinct 1 (for herself).
