





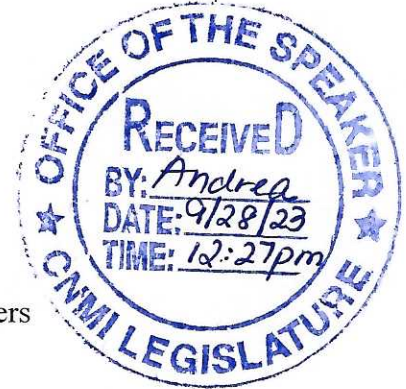

- a. **HB 23-12:** "To amend 1 CMC § 7831 to provide for direct legislative appropriation to the Office of the Public Auditor, and for other purposes."
- b. **HB 23-19:** "To provide a tax credit for taxpayers who make donations of cash or food supplies to a qualified local food pantry, homeless shelter, or soup kitchen."
- c. **HB 23-52:** "To authorize the CDA that they must write off the principal sum and interest loan extended to the CUC; and for other purposes."

### V. NEW BUSINESS

- a. **HB 23-62:** "To amend 4 CMC § 1205 to include the CNMI Women's Association and the NMTI as qualified educational institutions to benefit from the education tax credit."
- b. **HB 23-72:** "To establish a Department of Labor Revolving Fund and authorize the collection of fees through the Administrative Hearing Office for services to other agencies."
- c. **HB 23-74:** "To impose an additional 3% tax on the yearly gross revenue of construction activities in excess of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars for a period of three years."
- d. **HB 23-75:** "To re-appropriate Thirteen Thousand Four Hundred One Dollars (\$13,401.00) allotted under Public Law No. 20-61; and for other purposes."
- e. **HLB 23-21:** "To re-appropriate Four Thousand Twenty-Six Dollars (\$4,026.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 19-3 and Forty Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars (\$40,334.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-26; and for other purposes."
- f. **HLB 23-25:** "To re-appropriate Two Hundred Four Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$204,500.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 20-26, specifically under BU 7186W; One Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$190,000.00) allotted under Saipan Local Law 21-07, specifically under BU 49630; and for other purposes."
- g. **HLB 23-26:** "To re-appropriate Three Hundred Thousand Dollars allotted under SLL 21-10; and for other purposes."

- h. **HLB 23-27:** "To re-appropriate Fifty Thousand Dollars allotted under SLL 20-26, Section 2(r)(1), specifically under BU 7190D; and for other purposes."
- i. **HLB 23-28:** "To re-appropriate Twenty-One Thousand Four Hundred and Forty-Eight Dollars (\$21,448.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-04; and Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) allotted under Rota Local Law 22-09; and for other purposes."
- j. **SJR 23-2:** "Requesting the MPLT to authorize the use of the Park Fund Income for other purposes and to seek the concurrence of the United States Government for such authorization."
