10	WHEREAS, Match Scholarship recipients, or students who were matched
11	to a college, receive a scholarship worth over \$325,000; and

1	WHEREAS, high achieving student Ms. Clarize Crystal Paraiso
2	Rodriguez, from Tinian High School was one of the recipients of the Match
3	Scholarship; and
4	WHEREAS, Ms. Clarize Crystal Paraiso Rodriguez was matched to the
5	University of Chicago and will be attending the university during the fall of 2024;
6	and
7	WHEREAS, Ms. Clarize Crystal Paraiso Rodriguez was inspired to apply
8	through the competitive program in hopes to further her education with no financial
9	struggle; and
10	WHEREAS, in order to receive that opportunity, Ms. Clarize Crystal
11	Paraiso Rodriguez worked extremely hard to ensure her application stood out; and
12	WHEREAS, Ms. Clarize Crystal Paraiso Rodriguez joined various clubs in
13	which she enjoyed, such as Army JROTC, 4-H Marianas, the National Honor
14	Society, her school's Student Council, sports clubs, and even a variety of
15	internships throughout her high school career; and
