A YOUTH CONGRESS RESOLUTION

To recognize and commemorate Herman's Modern Bakery for 80 years of remarkable service to the people of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

1	WHEREAS, the Youth Congress recognizes and acknowledges those
2	businesses that make significant impacts on our economy and for the betterment of
3	the lives for people of all ages in the Commonwealth; and
4	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas is proud to
5	recognize the hard work and dedication our post-war pioneers had for our economy
6	and for the future of our islands; and
7	WHEREAS, after the Japanese occupation and the Battle of Saipan, the
8	U.S Armed Forces selected the late Herman R. Guererro to bake hundreds of loaves
9	of bread daily in order to feed local families, prisoners of war, and troops; and
10	WHEREAS, after encouragement from the United States Navy in 1944, the
11	late Herman R. Guererro opened Herman's Modern Bakery which was not only his
12	first business, but the first legitimate business opened on Saipan; and
13	WHEREAS, Herman's Modern Bakery was incorporated in 1979 which
14	was a critical step in the growth and expansion of the business; and

1	WHEREAS, Herman's Bakery is one of the largest and one of the most
2	well-known locally-owned business in the Commonwealth; and
3	WHEREAS, the Herman's Modern Bakery registered its trademark name
4	and baker's hat logo with the U.S. Registry of Patents and Trademarks on January
5	21, 2003, the first in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands; and
6	WHEREAS, Herman's Modern Bakery continues to be a leader in the
7	community and a shining example of how a business can truly impact a community
8	for the better; and
9	WHEREAS, the children and grandchildren of the late Herman "Pan" R.
10	and Maria "Tan Marikita" T. Guererro continue to carry their proud legacy of hard
11	work, dedication, and love for serving their community; and
12	WHEREAS, for many years now, Herman's Modern Bakery has been
13	influential for many youths across the Commonwealth sparking the idea of the
14	chance for opportunity and success within our islands; and
15	WHEREAS, Herman's Modern Bakery also served as a gateway into the
16	workforce for many of the Commonwealth's youth; and
17	WHEREAS, during the many challenges faced by the Commonwealth
18	Herman's Modern Bakery was always there to help provide meals and food for
19	families all across the Commonwealth; and
20	WHEREAS, Herman's Modern Bakery also supplies bread, buns, and
21	other bakery products to over 70 local retail stores and restaurants on our islands;

1 WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Youth 2 Congress extends it deepest and heartfelt gratitude to Herman's Modern Bakery for 3 investing 80 years of their services to the communities and other businesses on our 4 islands and for serving as an inspiration for opportunity to the youth of the 5 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands: 6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Nineteenth 7 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Youth Congress, that the Youth Congress recognize this momentous and historical milestone, the 80th Anniversary 8 9 of Herman's Modern Bakery; and 10 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Sponsor of this Resolution or the 11 designee of the Speaker of the Youth Congress shall present a certified original 12 copy of this Youth Congress Resolution to the Herman's Modern Bakery 13 management; and 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Speaker of the Youth Congress 15 shall certify, and the Youth Congress Legislative Secretary shall attest to the 16 adoption of this commemorative resolution and thereafter shall transmit a certified 17 copy to the Honorable Edmund S.
