## A YOUTH CONGRESS RESOLUTION

Congratulating Kelly Zheng, Mai Peters, YuLing Chai, and Jedric Aniciete for winning the 2024 Congressional App Challenge and representing the Nothern Marianas Islands Youth in the 2025 #HOUSEOFCODE event in Washington D.C.

1	WHEREAS, the Congressional App Challenge is an annual competition held
2	across the United States and its territories for middle and high school students to
3	showcase their coding and app development skills; and
4	WHEREAS, the Congressional App Challenge was established through U.S
5	House Resolution-77 to foster an appreciation for computer science and S.T.E.M;
6	and
7	WHEREASS, the Congressional App Challenge held its first official
8	challenge in 2016 and has now expanded to inspire over 40,00 students across all
9	50 states and its territories to code for Congress; and
10	WHEREAS, state winners of the Congressional App Challenge are invited
11	to the #HouseofCode event, an opportunity for their works to be showcased to
12	members of Congress at Capitol Hill in Washington D.C; and

1	WHEREAS, the 2024 Congressional App Challenge accepted submissions
2	for judging by congressional representatives by October 24, 2024; and
3	WHEREAS, 20 high school teams in the CNMI competed to win the 2024
4	Congressional App Challenge; and
5	WHEREAS, Kelly Zheng and Jedric Aniciete from Marianas High School
6	registered a team with Mai Peters and YuLing Chair from Saipan Southern High
7	School in August 2024; and
8	WHEREAS, Jedric Aniciete and Kelly Zheng acted as the main
9	programmers, with Mai Peters acted as the graphic designer and YuLing Chai acted
10	as the researcher; and
11	WHEREAS, Kelly Zheng, Jedric Aniciete, Mai Peters, and YuLing Chai
12	independently learned to code their app in the Swift programming language through
13	video tutorials; and
14	WHEREAS, Kelly Zheng, Jedric Aniciete, Mai Peters, and YuLing Chai
15	received mentorship advice from Mrs. Karen Camacho, an A.P Computer Science
16	teacher from Saipan Southern High School; and
17	WHEREAS, Kelly Zheng, Jedric Aniciete, Mai Peters, and YuLing Chai
18	submitted their app project called Neni, an educational tool that teaches Chamorro
19	for younger students; and
20	WHEREAS, the app Neni aimed to address issues with cultural preserving
21	the Chamorro Language within the CNMI Youth; and

1	WHEREAS, the app Neni used effective, active-recall learning techniques
2	like an Artificial Intelligence object identifier tool, flashcards, matching-pattern
3	games, and children's songs in Chamorro; and
4	WHEREAS, the app Neni featured over 150+ Chamorro words and
5	translations accessible for free to download and utilize; and
6	WHEREAS, Kelly Zheng, Jedric Aniciete, Mai Peters, and YuLing Chai's
7	app received the most points in the judging period amongst other CNMI high school
8	competitors; and
9	WHEREAS, Kelly Zheng, Jedric Aniciete, Mai Peters, and YuLing Chai
10	were awarded as winners on December 2 through email sent by Congressman
11	Gregorio Kilili Camacho Sablan;
12	WHEREAS, Kelly Zheng, Jedric Aniciete, Mai Peters, and YuLing Chai
13	were published and posted by Congressman Gregorio Kilili Camacho Sablan's
14	team through his official website and Instagram social media page; and
15	WHEREAS, Kelly Zheng, Jedric Aniciete, Mai Peters, and YuLing Chai
16	were invited to Congressman Gregorio Kilili Camacho Sablan's district office in
17	Saipan to receive their formal invitation to the 2025 #HouseofCode Event in April
18	2025;
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Nineteenth
20	Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Youth Congress that the Youth
21	Congress congratulates Kelly Zheng, Mai Peters, YuLing Chai, and Jedric Aniciete
22	for winning the 2024 Congressional App Challenge and representing the Nothern

1	Marianas Islands Youth in the 2025 #HOUSEOFCODE event in Washington D.C;
